- 1. I no longer need to feel condemned by God for my compulsion to do things dishonoring to Him.
 - **Philippians 3:6-9** Paul, a righteous man, gave up trying to be perfect in order to depend on Jesus for transformation.
 - Romans 7:18-24 Paul admitted continually finding something within himself that was opposed to God.
 - **Romans 8:1** Paul, because of Jesus, found liberation from all concern for condemnation for the way he was as a typical human being.

- 2. My new focus in life is depending upon the principle of "Holy Spirit Influence" in my life.
 - **Rom. 8:2** The principle of "Spirit dependence" is liberation from the principle of self-improvement based upon my control.
 - **Rom. 8:3** Jesus condemned all dependence upon self-discipline as our only solution for our flawed human nature and tendencies.
 - **Rom. 8:4** Jesus intends us to depend upon the Holy Spirit to do within us what we are incapable of doing ourselves.
- 3. Our commitment to "Holy Spirit Influence" is commitment to consistently thinking about what He teaches us.
 - **Rom. 8:5** Our thoughts become the meditations of our hearts and the predominant influence in our choices.

"Spirit Informed" Thoughts are Not Rules

- We are already blessed with every possible blessing in the heavenly realm. (I Cor. 2:12; I Pet. 1:13)
- We are children of God with full and complete access to Him, as our true Father, whenever we need Him.

(Hebrews 10:19-22)

- God has made pleasing Him so easy that all we have to do is love and serve the family of God. (Galatians 5)
- God understands me completely. (I Cor. 10:13)
